

Message from the President

#### October 20, 2021

It is no secret that the past year and a half has been challenging for all. Despite the uncertainties of the pandemic, the Headingley Community Foundation (HCF) has continued to experience growth with new donors, new funds, and new partnerships, and we continue to be amazed by the generosity of our community.

The cancellation of in-person events meant a new approach to fundraising. We sold amaryllis bulbs, orchids, and held a very successful online 50/50 raffle. For a little bit of fun, we also sponsored a Giant Pumpkin Contest with the Phoenix Recreation Association. These were all first-time initiatives which we are happy to report will continue yearly, depending on demand.

To our surprise, this year brought the formation of two new funds. We are very pleased to welcome the Headingley Senior Services and the Phoenix Recreation Association Designated Funds for two reasons. Firstly, this will ensure these groups have funding moving forward, forever. Secondly, we are happy to have built such a good reputation in our community. It really says something that groups are now coming to us, instead of the other way around. I would like to thank the community groups who have put their trust in us, and I applaud the efforts of the dedicated Board members who have, over the past six years, fostered these new relationships.

Since our inception in 2015, we have seen a steady increase in granting to community groups. This year, as you can see, we gave out almost \$17,000 in grants. HCF was also the conduit for federal funding through the Emergency Community Support Fund (ECSF) which brought an additional \$70,000 into our community. Along with many other important community projects, the most visible one is the new Phoenix School Outdoor Classroom which has already been used extensively this fall by classes and teachers.

None of our accomplishments would be possible without the support of donors and the commitment of volunteers. On behalf of the HCF Board, I would like to extend our sincere gratitude and appreciation for all your help. Together, we will face whatever tomorrow brings and continue to strengthen HCF's bond and commitment to the residents of Headingley.




